Jobs decreased by 1,950 over the last 5 years but are projected to grow by 714 over the next 5 years.

Median household income is \$13.4K below the national median household income of \$60.3K.

Takeaways

- As of 2020 the region's population increased by 2.9% since 2015, growing by 3,496. Population is expected to increase by 2.4% between 2020 and 2025, adding 2,886.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs declined by 3.0% in Jasper County, MO from 65,456 to 63,506. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 6.2% by 9.2%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 61.8% to 58.7% between 2015 and 2020.
- Concerning educational attainment, **15.7% of Jasper County**, **MO residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (3.4% below the national average), and **7.2% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.0% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and General Freight Trucking.






Unemployment Rate Trends


Millennials

Jasper County, MO has 25,122 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 25,016.




Veterans

Jasper County, MO has 7,299 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 6,862.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Jasper County, MO. The national average for an area this size is 35,673 people 55 or older, while there are 34,042 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Jasper County, MO. The national average for an area this size is 48,397 racially diverse people, while there are 19,958 here.




Property Crime








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry LQ






Top Industry GRP
















Top Growing Occupations







Top Occupation Earnings


2019 Median Hourly Earnings





Unique Average Monthly Postings





Educational Pipeline

In 2019, there were 1,767 graduates in Jasper County, MO. This pipeline has grown by 18% over the last 5 years. The highest share of these graduates come from "Business/Commerce, General", Bible/Biblical Studies, and Criminal Justice/Police Science.
