- From 2015 to 2020, jobs increased by 1.3% in 2 MSAs from 99,229 to 100,474. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 6.2% by 4.9%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 60.8% to 58.5% between 2015 and 2020.
- Concerning educational attainment, **13.8% of the selected regions' residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (5.3% below the national average), and **7.9% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.2% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).






















Top Industry GRP











Top Occupation Earnings


2019 Median Hourly Earnings








