- As of 2020 the region's population increased by 0.9% since 2015, growing by 425. Population is expected to increase by 0.6% between 2020 and 2025, adding 308.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs declined by 1.1% in Cherokee County, OK from 19,669 to 19,456. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 6.2% by 7.3%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 48.9% to 46.8% between 2015 and 2020.
- Concerning educational attainment, **15.2% of Cherokee County, OK residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (3.9% below the national average), and **6.4% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.8% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Education and Hospitals (State Government).





As of 2020 the region's population increased by 0.9% since 2015, growing by 425. Population is expected to increase by 0.6% between 2020 and 2025, adding 308.



Job Trends






Unemployment Rate Trends

Cherokee County, OK had an August 2020 unemployment rate of 4.83%, decreasing from 5.17% 5 years before.






Millennials

Cherokee County, OK has 8,918 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 10,032.




Veterans

Cherokee County, OK has 3,418 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 2,769.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Cherokee County, OK. The national average for an area this size is 14,306 people 55 or older, while there are 14,248 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is high in Cherokee County, OK. The national average for an area this size is 19,409 racially diverse people, while there are 25,720 here.




Property Crime








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry LQ






Top Industry GRP














Top Growing Occupations







Top Occupation Earnings


2019 Median Hourly Earnings






