- From 2015 to 2020, jobs declined by 0.9% in Joplin, MO from 85,908 to 85,094. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.1% by 4.0%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 61.9% to 59.6% between 2015 and 2020.
- Concerning educational attainment, **16.0% of Joplin, MO residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (4.1% below the national average), and **7.7% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.9% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and General Medical and Surgical Hospitals.





Job Trends




Unemployment Rate Trends


Millennials

Joplin, MO has 35,447 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 37,023.




Retiring Soon

Joplin, MO has 3.02 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.53 per 1,000 people.




Property Crime









Top Occupation Earnings


2019 Median Hourly Earnings








