- As of 2020 the region's population **declined by 0.7%** since 2015, falling by 255. Population is expected to **increase by 0.5%** between 2020 and 2025, adding 211.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs declined by 1.4% in Crawford County, KS from 19,806 to 19,529. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 1.3% by 2.7%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate increased from 59.0% to 61.1% between 2015 and 2020.
- Concerning educational attainment, **19.2% of Crawford County**, **KS residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (0.8% below the national average), and **8.3% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.3% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.









Unemployment by Ethnicity







Crawford County, KS had a January 2021 unemployment rate of 4.62%, decreasing from 4.82% 5 years before.






Top Growing Industries



Top Industry LQ




Top Industry GRP




2020 Gross Regional Product







Top Growing Occupations





Top Occupation Earnings






Top Posted Occupations




Unique Average Monthly Postings
