### **Takeaways**

- As of 2020 the region's population increased by 3.4% since 2015, growing by 4,028. Population is expected to increase by 4.2% between 2020 and 2025, adding 5,161.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs declined by 7.1% in Jasper County, MO from 66,044 to 61,385. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 1.3% by 8.4%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 62.2% to 59.8% between 2015 and 2020.
- Concerning educational attainment, **17.2% of Jasper County**, **MO residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (2.9% below the national average), and **7.0% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.6% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and General Merchandise Stores, including Warehouse Clubs and Supercenters.













## **Population Trends**




### **Job Trends**


## **Unemployment Rate Trends**

Jasper County, MO had a January 2021 unemployment rate of 4.59%, increasing from 4.16% 5 years before.






#### **Millennials**

Jasper County, MO has 25,122 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 25,016.




#### **Veterans**

Jasper County, MO has 7,048 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 6,739.




#### **Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is about average in Jasper County, MO. The national average for an area this size is 35,672 people 55 or older, while there are 34,042 here.




#### **Violent Crime**

Racial diversity is low in Jasper County, MO. The national average for an area this size is 48,396 racially diverse people, while there are 19,957 here.




#### **Property Crime**






#### 2020 Median Hourly Earnings








