- From 2015 to 2020, jobs increased by 13.6% in Newton County, MO from 19,863 to 22,562. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 1.3% by 12.3%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 60.8% to 57.5% between 2015 and 2020.
- Concerning educational attainment, **13.5% of Newton County, MO residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (6.5% below the national average), and **9.2% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.6% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are General Medical and Surgical Hospitals, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.






Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity










Unemployment Rate Trends

Newton County, MO had a May 2021 unemployment rate of 3.97%, decreasing from 4.35% 5 years before.










Veterans

Newton County, MO has 4,316 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 3.234.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Newton County, MO. The national average for an area this size is 17,122 people 55 or older, while there are 18,885 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Newton County, MO. The national average for an area this size is 23,229 racially diverse people, while there are 8,329 here.




Property Crime




















2020 Median Hourly Earnings







Educational Pipeline

In 2019, there were 1,360 graduates in Newton County, MO. This pipeline has grown by 53% over the last 5 years. The highest share of these graduates come from General Studies, Truck and Bus Driver/Commercial Vehicle Operator and Instructor, and Registered Nursing/Registered Nurse.
